The programme

The Institutional Research Programme gives institutions and intermediaries the work of the twelve sector desks and the Information and Data division. It covers five origination sectors and seven deployment sectors. It is the same research the Investment Committee reads before it commits capital.

Research is published on a calendar, not on request. Sixty pieces have been issued since 2021, each with a named author and a date. Subscribers receive them on the morning of publication, together with the underlying series and the definitions used to build them.

What is included

- A monthly research note from one of the twelve sector desks, published on a fixed calendar with a named author.
- A quarterly sector briefing covering exposure, positions and the movement of capital between the twelve sectors.
- The data series behind each note, with the definitions and the collection method used to build them.
- Two analyst sessions a year with the desk that wrote the work, held under the Marketing and Financial Promotions policy.
- An annual data appendix covering trade flows by corridor, by product class and by month, drawn from datasets the institution owns.
- A written statement of which analysis was model-assisted, as the sixth principle of the Ethical Technology Charter requires.

Eligibility

The programme is available to institutions, intermediaries and family offices that qualify as eligible counterparties or professional investors in their own jurisdiction. It is offered to no retail client anywhere. Enquiries reach enquiries@iguako.tech.

Reporting
